

South Brisbane Sailing Club – Boat Storage.

South Brisbane Sailing Club Inc has some storage available for sailing dinghies under the clubhouse, but we never expect to be able to cater for all of our members. The club's preferred position is that our members will take their boats home with them.

The available storage, however, is allocated on a "first request" basis with each application lasting for one season only.

In addition, any application has strict conditions attached to it.

1. An application for storage will only be approved, and the storage space maintained, on the basis that the owner is a regular sailor. As a guideline, we expect such a sailor to sail for more than three weekends out of four, and we retain the right to re-allocate a space if any pattern of lesser use arises.

While we will treat any substantial reason for limited use (such as injury or sickness or similar) in a sympathetic way, we will expect the person concerned to advise us as soon as practicable of the reasons for non-use. We will also expect that person to make every effort to turn up to the club and assist with non-sailing duties when they are not sailing.

Boat owners who are asked to remove their boat will be given 14 clear days from their receipt of our letter requesting removal to remove their boat. From that time, an additional fee of \$50/week will apply until the boat is removed.

2. Our rack system of boat storage limits our ability to store any boat trolleys. Only those boats approved for the bottom level storage will be allowed to retain a trolley within the boat storage area. We will try to have one trolley available for common use for each boat class, but boat owners will need to make their own arrangements for personal trolleys.
3. The boat storage fee is only available on an annual basis, but the club will consider refunds if we ask for a boat to be removed, or if the owner elects to relinquish their space for any reason.
4. While we will make every effort to ensure that the boats in our care are not damaged in any way, the owner must indemnify the club against any damage that is beyond our control. Such situations may arise due to building problems or collapse, fire, flood and so on.



Boat Storage Application – South Brisbane Sailing Club Inc.

In making an application to have my boat stored at South Brisbane Sailing Club, I agree to the following conditions:

1. I understand that a boat space will only be allocated to me if a suitable one is available, and that I must re-apply every year for continued storage.
2. I understand that, if the storage space is relinquished for any reason, I may apply for an appropriate refund of the storage fee.
3. I understand that storage of my boat requires me to sail it regularly for more than three times per month. I further understand that I must advise the relevant club officers if there is a good reason why I cannot sail for a period.
4. I understand that I may be asked to remove my boat if I do not sail the boat regularly. I also understand that I will be charged \$50/week if I do not remove my boat within 14 clear days of receiving a written request to do so.
5. I understand that, if my boat is allocated a space on the middle or upper level racks, I will have to make alternative arrangements for the storage of any personal boat trolley.
6. I will release South Brisbane Sailing Club and its officers against any loss or damage to my boat whatsoever, and not make any claim against said sailing club and its officers, except for wilful damage.
